

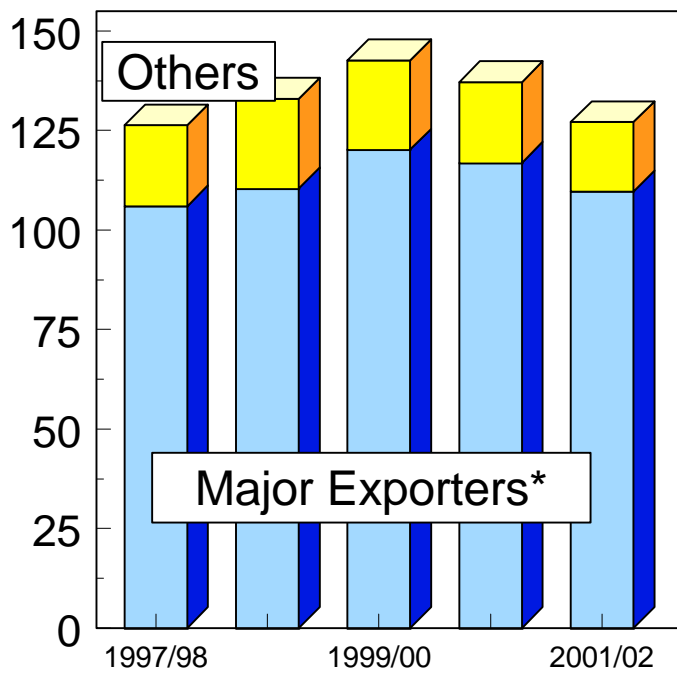


# Grain: World Markets and Trade

### World Stocks

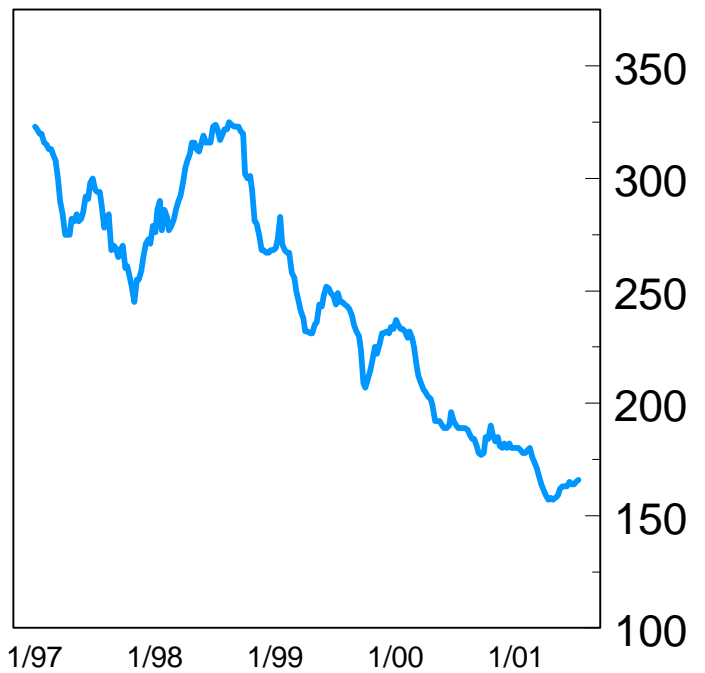
Million Metric Tons

An anomaly persists in 2001/02 as world rice prices continue to soften despite a projected decline in global ending stocks. Since the major exporters\* hold over 85% of the global stocks, they are the key price-setters in a market which lacks consistent import demand. Interest from traditional importers has waned in the absence of domestic production shortfalls or any expectation that global prices will strengthen in the near term.

In 2001/02, global rice trade is forecast to be stagnant and worldwide production is projected to be flat. Consumption, however, continues to rise steadily and is estimated to grow almost two percent fueled by global population growth. The result will be forecast tighter stocks, down 10 million tons, attributed primarily to an expected drawdown in China which holds at least two-thirds of global carryover. Conversely, India, a major exporter, is reportedly developing plans to utilize or sell-off stocks which could risk a short-term price shock if those excess supplies are dumped on the world market.

# SITUATION AND OUTLOOK: COMMENTARY AND CURRENT DATA

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## WORLD WHEAT SITUATION AND OUTLOOK

World wheat trade in 2001/02 is forecast to be 107.3 million tons, up 4.3 million tons from 2000/01. Global production is forecast down as smaller crops in the United States, Canada, EU, China, and South Asia more than offset increases in Eastern Europe, FSU, North Africa, and Argentina. Consumption is expected to remain well above production for the third consecutive year leading global stocks to fall an estimated 25 million tons from last year to their lowest level in 19 years.

Wheat prices have fallen significantly over the past month with harvest pressure. In early July export quotes for #2 HRW FOB Gulf averaged \$124/MT, down \$10 from last month despite indications of tightening exportable supplies in some key countries. Expected global production fell nearly 1.5 million tons from last month mainly due to smaller expected crops in Australia, Canada, and the EU. Global consumption is expected down 1.2 million tons while ending stocks are forecast up almost 1 million tons. Though U.S. exports are estimated up, world wheat trade in 2001/02 is forecast down slightly from last month.

### 2001/2002 Trade Changes

#### Selected Exporters

- ◆ **Australia** down 1 million to 16.5 million based on lower expected production resulting from dryness in key producing regions.
- ◆ **Canada** down 500,000 tons to 18 million due to decreased crop prospects.
- ◆ **EU** down 500,000 tons to 13.5 million on prospects for a smaller French crop and tighter overall EU exportable supplies.
- ◆ **United States** up 1.5 million tons to 29.0 million based on a better-than-expected crop and decreased competition resulting from declining production prospects among competing exporters.

#### Selected Importers

- ◆ **Brazil** down 200,000 tons to 7.3 million with prospects for a larger crop.
- ◆ **Pakistan** down 500,000 tons to 500,000 due to a better expected crop.

- ◆ **Uzbekistan** up 400,000 tons to 1 million because of prospects for a smaller crop.

### 2000/2001 Trade Changes

#### Selected Exporters

- ◆ **Canada** down 500,000 tons to 17.5 million due to a slower export pace.
- ◆ **Turkey** down 200,000 tons to 1.3 million because of lower than expected shipments to date.
- ◆ **Hungary** down 200,000 tons to 1 million due to a lagging export pace.

#### Selected Importers

- ◆ **Brazil** down 300,000 tons to 7.6 million because of lower than expected purchases of Argentine wheat to date.
- ◆ **Iraq** up 200,000 tons to 3.2 million because of a strong import pace.
- ◆ **South Korea** down 200,000 tons to 3.3 million due to lower purchases of feed quality wheat to date.
- ◆ **Nigeria** up 100,000 tons to 1.6 million due to increased purchases.

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## WORLD RICE SITUATION AND OUTLOOK

Global production and trade for 2002 are projected virtually unchanged. However, ending stocks are projected to decline 10.0 million tons, mostly in China, to 127.2 million as global consumption is forecast to increase to a new record level of 405.7 million tons.

Note: Historical revisions are made to Indonesia's consumption and ending stocks back to 1970/71.

### Exporter Forecasts for 2002

**United States** calendar year exports are projected at 2.6 million tons, a decline of 50,000 tons from the current year. Production is expected to reach 8.8 million tons (rough basis), increasing 140,000 tons from the current year. Despite an anticipated increase in rough rice exports, total exports are expected to fall, as the United States is not price competitive.

The export forecast for **Thailand** is flat, at 6.7 million tons as rice production is expected to be unchanged from the previous record crop.

Exports by **Vietnam** are expected to increase to 4.3 million tons, up 300,000 from the 2001 forecast. Production (paddy basis) is projected at 31.8 million tons, rising approximately 300,000 tons year-to-year.

**China's** exports are estimated to be 200,000 tons above the current year's forecast, reaching 2.0 million, with smaller production and consumption, stocks are expected to fall by 7.6 million tons.

Calendar year exports by **India** are forecast to increase slightly from the current year projections to 1.0 million tons owing to better price-competitiveness and stronger demand in Bangladesh, their largest market. Production (paddy basis) is forecast to again outpace consumption, leading to a fourth consecutive year of stocks build up.

The export forecast for **Pakistan** is expected to fall from the current year's projection of 2.25 million tons to 2.0 million as production (paddy basis) is expected to fall 300,000 tons. Consequently, Pakistan is expected to draw down ending stocks to approximately 400,000 tons.

**Argentina** and **Uruguay** are expected to reduce exports to 250,000 and 650,000 tons, respectively due to lower domestic production and a slight decline in Latin American import demand.

The export forecast for **Egypt** is raised 25,000 tons to 525,000 while production is projected to remain flat year-to-year as Egypt is price competitive, particularly in Turkey.

**Burma's** exports are projected to fall as government export and pricing policies are slow to respond to the changes in the global market.

### Importers Forecasts for 2002

#### **North America**

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The **United States** is expected to import 315,000 tons, an increase of 5,000 tons over the current year's forecast as consumption of fragrant and speciality varieties is expected to continue to rise.

Total imports by **Mexico** are projected to remain flat at a projected 425,000 tons as imports of rough rice are expected to continue to be strong to supply the Mexican milling industry.

### **Latin America**

Regionally, imports are expected to fall less than 100,000 tons even though production (paddy basis) remains relatively flat year-to-year. Imports by **Brazil** are expected to be flat at 500,000 tons, with consumption expected to be unchanged, as a result of a shift to more diverse diets.

### **Middle East**

Increased imports in 2002 are anticipated as regional production (paddy basis) drops for the second consecutive year as a result of dry weather conditions. Consequently, forecast rice imports by **Iran** are expected to increase 250,000 tons in 2002 to 1.25 million.

### **Other Africa**

While **Africa's** production is expected to rise slightly and regional imports are expected to decline, stocks are forecast to be drawn-down as regional consumption increases.

Imports by **Nigeria** are forecast to decline as production is expected to increase and ending stocks build. Rising consumption is also anticipated.

### **South Asia**

**South Asia's** production, imports and ending stocks are forecast to increase as consumption continues to rise.

**Bangladesh's** imports are forecast up as production is expected to fall from last year's record level by nearly 1 million tons. With consumption forecast up, ending stocks are forecast down.

### **Other Asia**

Imports by **Asia** are forecast flat for the third consecutive year. While production is expected to ease and consumption to increase, stocks are forecast to drop 10 million tons. **China** is expected to account for more than 75 percent of this decline, but **Indonesia** is also forecast to have a substantial drop in ending stocks.

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## WORLD COARSE GRAINS SITUATION AND OUTLOOK

World coarse grain trade for 2001/02 is projected down more than 2 million tons to 98.2 million tons, due to a production rebound from five-year-lows as bigger crops are anticipated in many regions of the world except the former Soviet Union, the EU, and the Western Hemisphere. Global consumption is expected to continue to outpace production and carryout stocks are forecast to fall almost 15 mmt. US corn, China corn, and EU barley are forecast to comprise nearly two-thirds of world coarse grain stocks.

Global corn trade is projected to be down marginally from a year earlier at 70.5 million tons. US exports are projected to increase 6 million tons from 2000/01 levels, mostly because of reduced competition from China. Although the US corn crop is expected to be smaller than last year and consumption is expected to increase, larger carryin stocks will limit the reduction in ending stocks. Chinese corn production is forecast to rebound partially from the 2000/01 drought-reduced level, but with consumption forecast up to record levels, stocks will continue to fall.

World barley trade is forecast to remain robust as Mid Eastern and North African demand continues strong. The EU will remain the largest supplier, although Australia is expected to increase exports.

### 2001/02 Trade Changes

#### Selected Exporters

- ◆ **China corn** down 1 million tons to 2 million due to continued high domestic prices.
- ◆ **Canada corn** up 300,000 tons to 800,000 tons due to an expected larger crop.
- ◆ **Canada barley** down 600,000 tons to 1.5 million due to lower expected production.
- ◆ **Australia barley** up 300,000 tons to 3.9 million based on decreased competition.
- ◆ **EU barley** down 500,000 tons to 8 million due to decreased crop prospects and high domestic prices.
- ◆ **United States sorghum** up 500,000 tons to 6.3 million because of expected continued strong demand from Mexico.

#### Selected Importers

- ◆ **Canada corn** down 200,000 tons to 800,000 based on a larger anticipated crop.
- ◆ **Indonesia corn** down 200,000 tons to 1.2 million due to the continued weakness of the Indonesian Rupiah.
- ◆ **Saudi Arabia barley** down 500,000 tons to 4.5 million due to weak demand for feeding.

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- ◆ **Mexico sorghum** up 500,000 tons to 4.5 million because of the expectation of continued strong demand from feedmillers.

#### 2000/01 Trade Changes

##### Selected Exporters

- ◆ **United States corn** down 1.5 million tons to 45 million due to a slow sales and shipment pace to date.
- ◆ **Argentina corn** up 500,000 tons to 13 million and **Brazil corn** up 1 million tons to 3 million because of a strong sales and shipment pace to date.
- ◆ **Ukraine barley** up 200,000 tons to 1 million based on a strong export pace to date.
- ◆ **EU barley** down 1 million tons to 8 million due to weaker global imports.
- ◆ **United States sorghum** up 100,000 tons to 5.7 million supported by continuing strong sales to Mexico.
- ◆ **Argentina sorghum** up 250,000 tons to 600,000 tons due to unusually strong early season shipments to Brazil.

##### Selected Importers

- ◆ **Canada corn** up 300,000 tons to 1.7 million supported by a strong pace of imports.
- ◆ **Mexico corn** down 500,000 tons to 5.5 million based on a slowdown of purchases resulting from fewer import licenses. In lieu of corn, **Mexico sorghum** up 200,000 tons to 4.3 million due to continued strong demand by feedmillers.
- ◆ **Algeria barley** up 200,000 tons to 900,000 based on purchases to date.
- ◆ **Saudi Arabia barley** down 500,000 tons to 4.5 million because of slow buying to date.
