



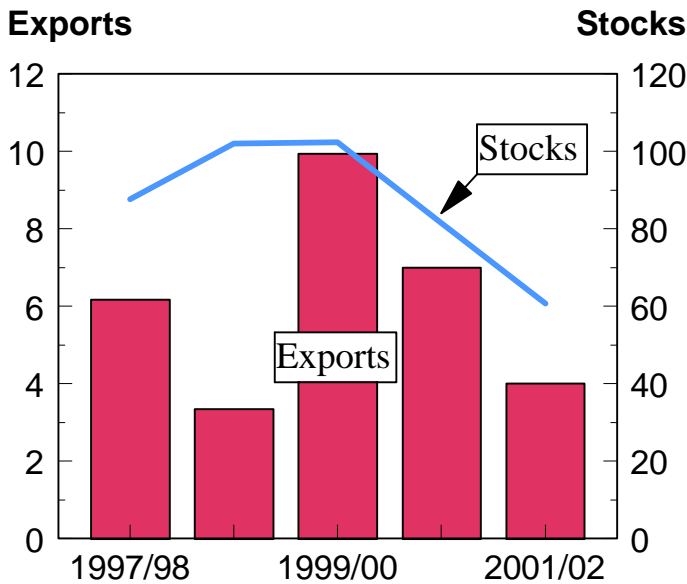

Chinese Exports and Stocks

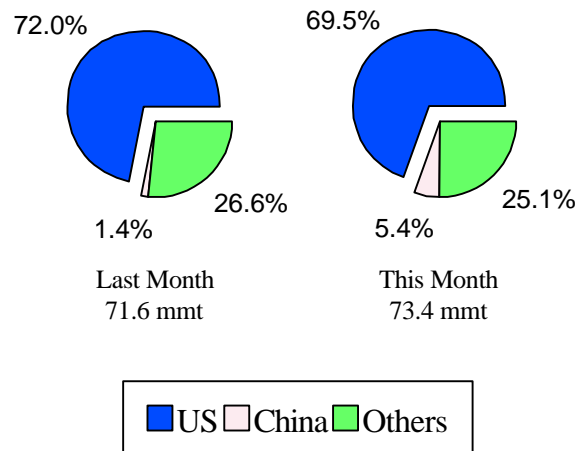

Chinese corn exports are forecast up 3 million tons to 4 million based in part on recent unexpected sales, in a likely attempt to reduce stocks before joining the WTO. Chinese domestic prices are above world levels, therefore requiring an export subsidy. However, they will not be able to subsidize sales after they join the WTO.

Since the United States normally dominates the Asian market, larger Chinese exports usually directly reduce US market share. However stronger demand, mainly in Canada, will largely mitigate the impact. As a result, US exports are currently projected to fall only 500,000 tons from last month, to 51,000 million.

SITUATION AND OUTLOOK: COMMENTARY AND CURRENT DATA

WORLD WHEAT SITUATION AND OUTLOOK

World wheat trade in 2001/02 is forecast to be 107.2 million tons, up 4.3 million tons from 2000/01. Global production is forecast to expand as increases in Eastern Europe, FSU, and Argentina more than offset smaller crops in Australia, Canada, EU, and Turkey. Consumption is expected to remain well above production for the third consecutive year leading global stocks to fall an estimated 24 million tons to the lowest level since 1988/89.

In early September, export quotes for #2 HRW FOB Gulf averaged \$127/MT, up only \$2 from last month as tightening exportable supplies in some major countries were countered by additional supplies from non-traditional exporters and lagging global import demand. Global production increased by more than three million tons compared to last month as production estimates in Eastern Europe, FSU, and Syria more than offset tighter crop prospects in Australia, Canada, EU and Turkey. Global consumption is forecast up nearly 1 million tons and ending stocks are estimated up more than 3 million tons. World wheat trade in 2001/02 is forecast 1 million tons higher than last month as higher expected exports from Russia, Ukraine, and Pakistan, more than offset lower exports from Australia, Canada, and Turkey.

2001/2002 Trade Changes

Selected Exporters

- ◆ **Australia** down 500,000 tons to 16 million due to smaller crop prospects.
- ◆ **Canada** down 500,000 tons to 16 million as a result of a smaller crop and tighter exportable supplies.
- ◆ **Russia** up 500,00 tons to 1.5 million based on better-than-expected crops.
- ◆ **Turkey** down 300,000 tons to 200,000 tons because of a lower crop.
- ◆ **Ukraine** up 1 million tons to 3.5 million in response to a larger crop.

Selected Importers

- ◆ **Brazil** down 500,000 tons to 6.5 million with prospects for a larger crop.

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- ◆ **South Korea** up 500,000 tons to 4.3 million based on higher expected feed wheat consumption.
 - ◆ **Nigeria** up 600,000 tons to 2.3 million because of continued strong demand.
 - ◆ **Turkey** up 200,000 tons to 1.2 million due to a smaller crop.

2000/2001 Trade Changes

Selected Exporters

- ◆ **Argentina** up 200,000 tons to 11.2 million due to higher than expected export shipments to date.
- ◆ **Australia and Canada** have been adjusted to reflect more complete official data.
- ◆ **Turkey** up 200,000 tons to 1.5 million due to increased sales at the end of the year.

Selected Importers

- ◆ **Indonesia** up 200,000 tons to 3.9 million as a result of strong imports late in the year.
- ◆ **Nigeria** up 600,000 tons to 2.2 million because of large, late season imports.

WORLD RICE SITUATION AND OUTLOOK

International market conditions have not changed much over the past month as thin demand and large exportable supplies continue to pressure prices. Global trade for 2001 is down slightly from last month's estimate at 22.2 million tons. While consumption continues to outpace production, ending stocks are expected to fall approximately 10 million tons in 2002.

In recent weeks, price quotes for high quality Viet rice have been on par with similar qualities from Thailand. Thai quotes have stabilized over the past four weeks due to consistent demand; Thai 100B export price quotes continue to average \$176 per ton. However, quotes out of Vietnam have changed many times throughout the month for a variety of reasons - flooding in the Mekong Delta, tight supplies, and increased port loadings. Ultimately, export price quotes for Viet 5% have averaged \$177 per ton.

With a projected record long grain harvest, price quotes for U.S. #2/4 have fallen to \$237 per ton (FAS), US Gulf sacked. In contrast, in response to a smaller harvest, price quotes for high quality medium grain have jumped \$40 per ton to \$225 per ton ex-spout Sacramento port.

- ◆ **United States exports** up 50,000 tons to 2.7 million based on projected lower prices.
- ◆ **Burma** up 100,000 tons to 350,000 based on competitive pricing and ample supplies to meet import demands in Africa and Bangladesh.
- ◆ **Egypt** up 125,000 tons to 650,000 based on a new government export subsidy program.

- ◆ **Egypt** up 125,000 tons to 650,000 based on a new government export subsidy program.
- ◆ **Burma exports** up 100,000 tons to 450,000 based on competitive pricing and expanded export pace to Africa and Bangladesh.
- ◆ **Egypt** up 50,000 tons to 550,000 due to pace to date which is a result of a new government export subsidy program.
- ◆ **Vietnam** down 200,000 tons to 3.8 million based on a slowing export pace and recent reports of smaller sales from government and private traders.

Selected Importers

- ◆ **Bangladesh imports** up 175,000 tons to 475,000 due to stepped up import demand, particularly for competitively priced Burmese rice.

WORLD COARSE GRAINS SITUATION AND OUTLOOK

World coarse grain trade for 2001/02 is projected down 2.3 million tons from the previous year to nearly 100 million tons. Global consumption is expected to continue to outpace production and carryout stocks are forecast to fall 25 million tons. US corn, China corn, and EU barley are forecast to comprise nearly two-thirds of world coarse grain stocks.

Global corn trade is projected to be down marginally from a year earlier at 73.4 million tons. US exports are projected to increase 3.5 million tons from 2000/01 levels, mostly because of reduced competition. A large drop in US carryout stock levels will result from a smaller crop, expanded use, and larger exports. The world barley market is shrinking with falling demand expected from Eastern European and Mid Eastern countries.

- ◆ **United States corn** down 500,000 tons to 51 million due to stronger competition.
- ◆ **China corn** up 3 million tons to 4 million because of recent unexpected sales.
- ◆ **South Africa corn** up 500,000 tons to 1.3 million based on anticipated continued strong sales to other African nations and Japan.
- ◆ **Canada corn** down 700,000 tons to 300,000 because of a much smaller crop.
- ◆ **Romania corn** down 200,000 tons to 800,000 based on a decrease in production.
- ◆ **EU barley** down 500,000 tons to 6.5 million due to tighter supplies of feed grains and strong domestic demand.
- ◆ **Canada barley and oats** down 200,000 tons to 1.2 and 1.1 million respectively due to prospects for smaller crops as a result of dryness in key producing areas.
- ◆ **Ukraine barley** up 500,000 tons to 1.5 million due to a larger anticipated crop.
- ◆ **Russia barley** up 100,000 tons to 800,000 due to higher crop prospects.
- ◆ **United States sorghum** down 200,000 to 6.1 million tons due to increased competition from Australia.
- ◆ **Australia sorghum** up 200,000 to 550,000 due to a projected increase in production.

Selected Importers

- ◆ **Canada corn** up 1.2 million tons to 2.5 million because of the smaller crop and an expected rise in feed use.
- ◆ **Indonesia corn** up 300,000 to 1.5 million tons due to a strengthening rupiah which causes imports to be cheaper.
- ◆ **Iran corn** up 300,000 to 1 million supported by a projected rise in feed use.
- ◆ **South Korea corn** down 500,000 tons to 7 million replaced by cheaper feed quality wheat imports.
- ◆ **Saudi Arabia barley** up 300,000 tons to 4.5 million due to expected strong feed demand.
- ◆ **United States oats** down 200,000 tons to 1.5 million based on smaller anticipated Canadian crop.

2000/01 Trade Changes

Selected Exporters

- ◆ **United States corn** up 1.5 million tons to 47.5 million based on recent strong sales and shipment pace to date.
- ◆ **Ukraine corn** down 200,000 tons to 100,000 based on a weak export pace to date.
- ◆ **Turkey barley** down 200,000 tons to 200,000 due to lagging import pace.
- ◆ **Russia barley** up 200,000 tons to 600,000 due to strong export pace to date.
- ◆ **Canada barley** up 100,000 tons to 2.1 million due to strong exports.
- ◆ **Australia sorghum** up 150,000 tons to 800,000 due to larger than expected shipments to Japan.

Selected Importers

- ◆ **Canada corn** up 600,000 tons to 2.3 million because of tightening domestic supply.
- ◆ **Egypt corn** up 300,000 tons to a record 5 million due to a thriving poultry industry.
- ◆ **Iran corn** up 300,000 tons to 1 million based on unexpected shipments from Brazil.
- ◆ **North Korea corn** up 250,000 tons to 650,000 due to China and U.S. food aid.

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- ◆ **South Korea corn** up 500,000 tons to 8.5 million supported by a stronger than expected purchase pace to date.
 - ◆ **Philippines corn** down 200,000 tons to 400,000 due to a weak import pace to date.
 - ◆ **Saudi Arabia barley** up 300,000 tons to 4.5 million based on purchases to date.
 - ◆ **Jordan barley** up 150,000 tons to 650,000 because of strong purchases to date.
 - ◆ **Morocco barley** down 100,000 tons to 600,000 due to weak import pace.
