




Oct 2001-Sep 2002 N. Africa Imports

Argentina and Brazil pose challenges to U.S. corn exports. Price sensitivity in North Africa--where the markets of Egypt, Algeria, Morocco, and Tunisia total 8.6 million tons--could mean a dramatic shift away from U.S. to cheaper South American corn.

Egypt is the largest importer in the region and has traditionally bought 80 percent of its corn from the United States, with Argentina filling in most of the rest. In 2001/02 the United States increased its market share as Argentina's exports declined because of financial and economic difficulties. However, the current trade year sees Egypt buying more Argentine corn. From October through December, Argentina has maintained an aggressive export pace in tandem with expanded soy meal shipments.

Meanwhile, Brazil has become a significant player in the region where it had almost no presence a year earlier. It has dominated Morocco's corn market since last October. The United States has traditionally covered 80 percent of Morocco's market, but so far this year has not made any sales there. Both Argentina and Brazil have made greater inroads into Algeria and Tunisia. U.S. corn exports will face tough competition from South American exporters in the coming months.

FAS Grain Trade Data and Seed: This report incorporates 1976/77 to 2001/02 historical revisions that include seed in USDA's estimates of U.S. grain trade. A spreadsheet containing the old and revised exports and imports can be found at:

For a number of years, USDA has excluded seed in its *international* trade year import/export forecasts for U.S. grains (July/June for wheat, Oct/Sept for coarse grains). This has led to some inconsistency with how we report trade in grain because we include seed for all countries, other than the United States, in both local and trade year data. USDA reports already include seed in *local* marketing year trade (and production) estimates for the United States.

SITUATION AND OUTLOOK: COMMENTARY AND CURRENT DATA

WORLD WHEAT SITUATION AND OUTLOOK

Year-to-Year Changes: World wheat trade in 2002/03 is forecast at 104.8 million tons, down 5.3 million tons from 2001/02. Global production is down 12.9 million tons, while consumption is up 12.7 million tons. Global stocks are expected to fall by 28.5 million tons to 172.8 million tons, the lowest level since 1996/97.

Changes from Last Month: The global wheat trade forecast is unchanged from last month. Lower imports by Iran and the United States are mostly offset by stronger purchases by the EU and Australia. Global production, consumption, and stocks are little changed.

Price: Early February export quotes for #2 HRW FOB Gulf averaged \$148/MT, down \$8 from last month.

2002/2003 Trade Changes

Selected Exporters

- **United States** down 500,000 tons to 24.5 million based on pace to date and strong export competition.
- **EU** up 500,000 tons to 15.5 million based on licenses to date and diminished competition from Russia and Ukraine.

Selected Importers

- **United States** down 250,000 tons to 1.7 million due to slow pace to date.
- **Iran** down 700,000 tons to 1.8 million because of an upward revision in last year's harvest, which has resulted in a sluggish purchase pace.
- **EU** up 500,000 tons to 10.5 million based on import licenses to date and anticipated fulfillment of TRQ allocations through June.

WORLD RICE SITUATION AND OUTLOOK

Year-to-Year Changes: Global trade in 2003 is estimated at 26.7 million tons, down 1.1 million tons from last year's estimate. Global production in 2002/03 is estimated at 382.1 million tons (milled basis), down 15.0 million tons from 2001/02; this can primarily be attributed to a drop in Indian production due to a weak monsoon. Global ending stocks in 2002/03 are estimated at 107.8 million tons, 26.6 million tons below revised 2001/02, with revisions mainly in China and India. Global consumption in 2002/03 is estimated at 408.6 million tons.

Price: Price quotes for Thai 100B strengthened \$7 this month and are currently quoted at \$204 per ton (FOB). Meanwhile, in Vietnam, increased demand from buyers in Southeast Asia offset the increased supplies of rice due to the harvest; currently, Viet 5% remains steady and is quoted at \$170 per ton (FOB). The uncertain availability of rail transport in India is forcing exporters to use trucks; export price quotes increased \$6 to \$166 per ton.

The export price quote for U.S. long grain grade #2/4 is up \$6 from last month and is currently quoted at \$208 per ton (FOB). Additionally, the price quote for California medium grain #1/4 strengthened \$10 to \$290 per ton (bulk, ex-spout Sacramento).

WORLD COARSE GRAINS SITUATION AND OUTLOOK

Year-to-Year Changes: World coarse grain trade in 2002/03 is unchanged from last year at nearly 102 million tons. Stocks are forecast to fall 26 million tons to 151 million. Chinese and U.S. corn together account for over half of global coarse grain stocks. Global stocks-to-use ratio will be 17.0 percent, the lowest since 1976/77. Compared to last year, global corn trade is increased 2 million tons to over 76 million in 2002/03. U.S. exports are down 1.6 million tons from last year and market share is down slightly.

Changes from Last Month: Global coarse grain trade is up over 1 million tons to nearly 102 million tons, led by higher corn imports by Japan and barley imports by the European Union. Corn exports for Brazil, Argentina, and China, and barley exports by the EU are higher. For the fifth consecutive month, the U.S. corn export projection is reduced, this time by 1.5 million tons in the face of increased competition. However, overall corn trade is up 700,000 tons due mostly to stronger imports by Japan.

2002/03 Trade Changes

Selected Exporters

- **U.S. corn** drops 1.5 million tons to 45.5 million because of strong competition and the dismal pace of exports.
- **Argentina corn** is up 500,000 tons to 10.5 million based on strong exports late in its 2001/02 local market year.
- **Brazil corn** is up 500,000 tons to 2.3 million due to higher production estimates.
- **China corn** is up 1.0 million tons to 12.0 million due to continued strong shipments and forward sales.
- **South Africa corn** is up 200,000 tons to 1.4 million due to a larger crop prospects.
- **EU barley** is up 500,000 tons to 5.0 million based on the export license pace and reduced competition from the Black Sea region.
- **Syria barley** is up 100,000 tons to 350,000 based on a government-to-government contract with Jordan beginning January 2003.
- **Ukraine barley** is down 300,000 tons to 3.2 million due to a slowdown in shipments.

Selected Importers

- **Japan corn** is up 500,000 tons to 16.0 million based on buoyant feed demand.

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- **Iran barley** is down 300,000 tons to 600,000 based on higher-than-expected production.
 - **EU barley** is up 200,000 tons to 500,000 based on larger than expected import licenses to date.
