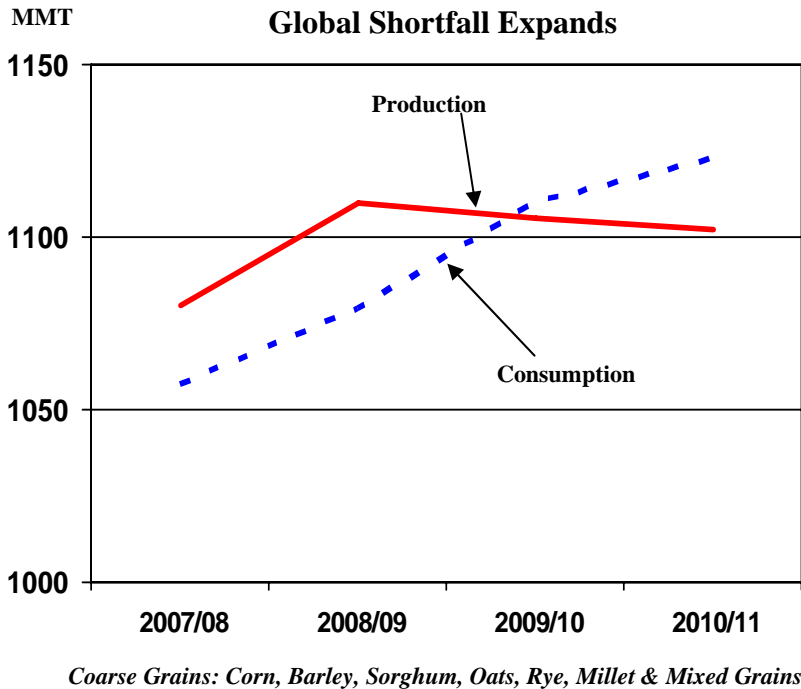
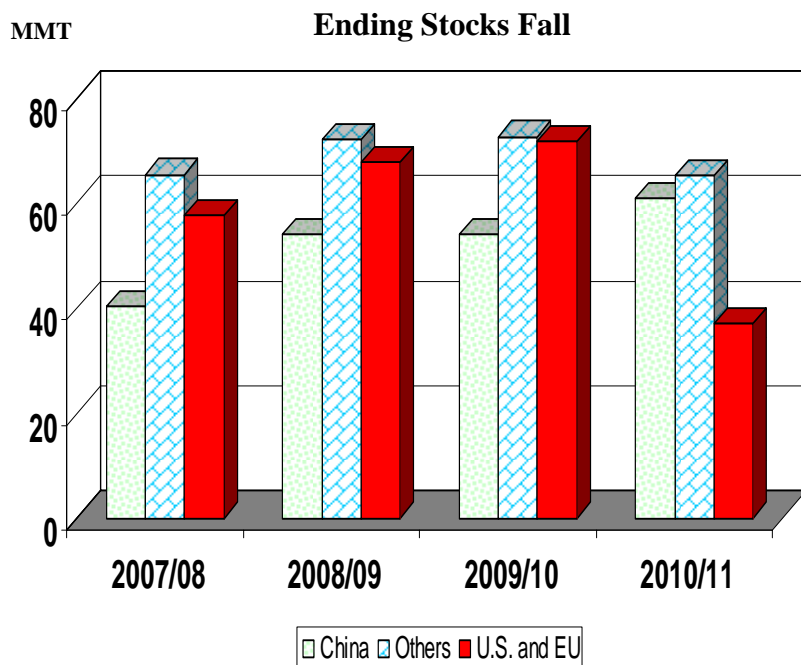


Grain: World Markets and Trade

Crop Shortfalls Deplete Global Coarse Grain Supplies



Global coarse grain supplies *available to the world* are expected to fall dramatically, as forecast crop reductions in key countries have significantly altered the supply outlook. In the United States, lower-than-expected corn yields have sharply reduced crop prospects. In the EU, where barley accounts for 40 percent of coarse grain production, lower area and yields have reduced the crop by 15 percent to the smallest level in over 10 years. Not all supplies are available to the world market. Many countries' stocks are held only for domestic use and strategic reserves, with China as the classic example.



At the same time, coarse grain stocks in the United States and the EU are forecast to drop nearly 50 percent (35 million tons). Corn stocks in the United States are expected to fall almost 50 percent (20 million tons) to the lowest level in 14 years (which is very tight in the context of the stocks-to-use ratio). Similarly, EU barley stocks are projected to fall 70 percent. The combined shortfalls present a much tighter supply picture than just a few months ago. However, Southern Hemisphere crops, currently in the early stages of planting, could help offset lower supplies in the Northern Hemisphere.

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The Foreign Agricultural Service (FAS) updates its production, supply and distribution database for cotton, oilseeds, and grains at 9 a.m. on the day the World Agricultural Supply and Demand Estimates (WASDE) report is released. 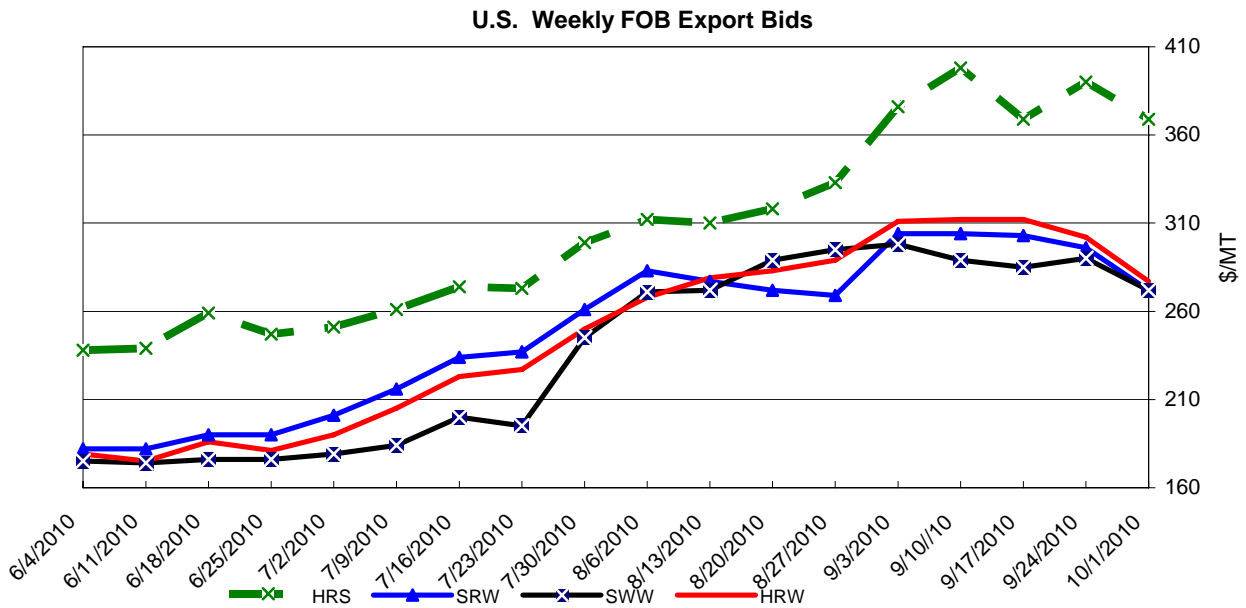

WHEAT: WORLD MARKETS AND TRADE



PRICES:

Domestic prices: Prices of all classes of wheat dropped in September due to growing expectations of ample global stocks. Hard Red Winter (HRW) and Soft Red Winter (SRW) both fell 11 percent to \$277/ton and \$272/ton, respectively. Soft White Wheat declined 9 percent to \$272/ton, the same price as SRW. Hard Red Spring fell 2 percent to \$369/ton.

TRADE CHANGES IN 2010/11

Selected Exporters

- **Uruguay** is doubled from 400,000 tons to 800,000 on larger exportable supplies and strong recent shipments.

Selected Importers

- **Algeria** is increased 300,000 tons to 5.3 million on reduced production.
- **Egypt** is raised 500,000 tons to 9.3 million on a stronger-than-expected import pace.
- **EU** is cut 500,000 tons to 5.5 million on tight exportable supplies of Black Sea feed-quality wheat.
- **Iran** is reduced 500,000 tons to 800,000 on lower import demand.

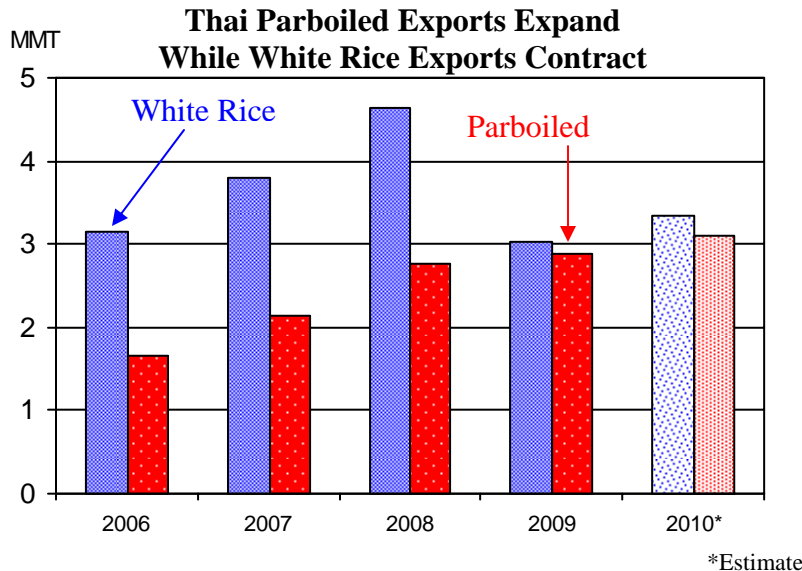

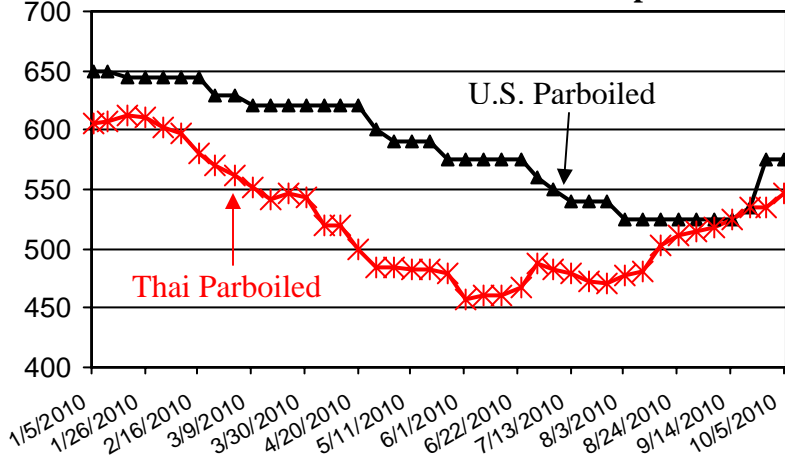
PARBOILED MARKET

Thai parboiled exports have been expanding for several years, while white rice exports have dropped off since 2008. India's export ban, relatively higher U.S. prices, and insufficient quantities from other suppliers have enabled Thailand to dominate the global parboiled market. In just 3 years, Thailand's share of global parboiled exports jumped from one-third to 90 percent. This contrasts with the white rice market, where Thailand has lost market share to lower-priced Vietnamese rice and has struggled to compete with historically higher-priced U.S. rice. If India lifts its export ban or cheaper suppliers such as Pakistan increase parboiling capacity, these dynamics could shift somewhat. For now, however, Thailand seems to have found its niche.

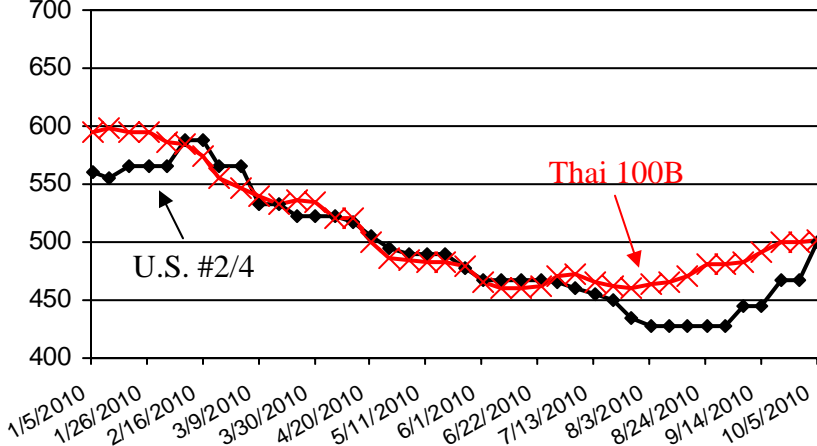
PRICES

Thai 100B quotes, up \$20 this month, have once again converged with U.S. #2/4 quotes, which surged \$55 to reach \$500 per ton, FOB. Whether U.S. quotes will continue on par with Thai quotes remains to be seen considering the disconnect between Thai prices and current market developments.

TRADE CHANGES

- **Indonesia's** imports are raised 200,000 tons to 700,000 for 2010 and 150,000 tons to 400,000 for 2011 as the government is considering purchases from Thailand and Vietnam.
- **Guinea's** imports are dropped 130,000 tons to 200,000 for 2010 and 150,000 tons to 225,000 tons for 2011 on expanded production and the slow pace of imports this year.
- **Burma's** 2011 exports are lowered 100,000 tons to 600,000 on a smaller crop.

COARSE GRAINS: WORLD MARKETS AND TRADE

PRICES:

Domestic: Through September, U.S. corn export prices gained \$10/ton but retreated following the USDA *Grain Stocks* report of September 30. Since then, concerns over U.S. corn yields have continued to support prices.

Argentine prices mirror U.S. prices and remain slightly higher. However, Brazilian corn has largely been priced at a significant premium due to logistical problems.

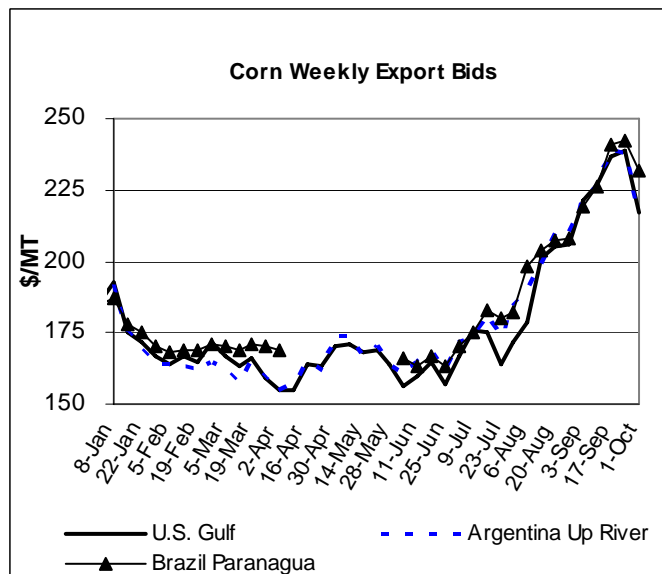
TRADE CHANGES IN 2010/11

Selected Exporters

- **U.S. corn** is cut 2.0 million tons to 51.5 million based on a sharply lower crop estimate.
- **Argentine corn** is boosted 1.5 million tons to 15.0 million because of larger crop prospects and lessened competition from the United States.
- **EU barley** is up 200,000 tons to 4.6 million, the highest in 8 years, due to demand from Russia for malting barley.
- **Mexican and Paraguayan corn** are raised a combined 500,000 tons based on strong regional demand.

Selected Importers

- **Canadian corn** is lowered 400,000 tons to 1.8 million because of large carryin stocks and lower domestic use.
- **Colombian, Indonesian, Korean, and Turkish corn** are raised a combined 900,000 tons because of strong feed demand.
- **EU corn** is cut 500,000 tons to 4.5 million with greater use of feed quality wheat.
- **Russian barley** is boosted 200,000 tons to 600,000, the highest in over a decade, because of tight supplies following a lower crop estimate.



TRADE CHANGES IN 2009/10

Selected Exporters

- **Argentine corn** is raised sharply by 1.3 million tons to a record 16.8 million because of unexpectedly large late-season shipments.
- **Brazilian corn** is boosted 700,000 tons to 8.2 million with strong demand from the EU and Iran.
- **Mexican, Paraguayan, and Uruguayan corn** are up a combined 900,000 tons based on trade data.

Selected Importers

- **Colombian and South Korean corn** are up 300,000 tons each based on trade data.
- **EU corn** is raised 400,000 tons to 2.9 million based on the highest quarterly import licenses in 2 years.
- **Iranian corn** is boosted 700,000 tons to a record 4.2 million based on trade data showing large late-season shipments from Argentina.
- **Venezuelan corn** is raised 300,000 tons to a record 2.0 million based on trade data.
- **Chinese barley** is up 200,000 tons to 2.1 million based on strong late-season imports of malting barley primarily from Australia.

OTHER NOTES

Local Marketing Years (LMY): LMY refers to the 12-month period following the main harvest, when the crop is marketed (i.e., consumed, traded, or stored). The year first listed begins a country's LMY for that commodity (2008/09 starts in 2008); except for summer grains in certain Southern Hemisphere countries and for rice in selected countries, where the second year begins the LMY (2008/09 starts in 2009). Stocks: Unless otherwise stated, stock data are based on an aggregate of differing local marketing years and should not be construed as representing world stock levels at a fixed point in time.

Consumption: World totals for consumption reflect total utilization, including food, seed, industrial, feed, and waste; as well as differences in local marketing year imports and local marketing year exports. Consumption statistics for regions and individual countries, however, reflect food, seed, industrial, feed, and waste only.

Trade: All PSD tables are balanced on the different local marketing years. All trade tables contain Trade Year (TY) data which puts all countries on a uniform, 12-month period for analytical comparisons: wheat is July/June; coarse grains, corn, barley, sorghum, oats, and rye are Oct/Sept; and rice is calendar year.

EU Consolidation: The trade figures starting from 1999/00 represent EU-27 and exclude all intra-trade. For the years 1960/61 through 1998/99, figures are the EU-15 and also exclude all intra-trade. EU-15 member states' data for grains are no longer maintained in the official USDA database. Data for the individual NMS-10, plus Bulgaria and Romania, exists only prior to 1999/00.

Statistics: (1) Wheat trade statistics include wheat, flour, and selected pasta products on a grain equivalent basis. (2) Rice trade statistics include rough, brown, milled, and broken on a milled

equivalent basis. (3) Coarse grains statistics include corn, barley, sorghum, oats, rye, millet, and mixed grains but exclude trade in barley malt, millet, and mixed grains.

Unaccounted: This term includes grain in transit, reporting discrepancies in some countries, and trade to countries outside the USDA database.
