


Grain: World Markets and Trade

Russia Wheat Exports Down on Lower Supplies



Based on drought in major winter wheat growing areas, Russia's 2019/20 wheat production forecast was reduced this month by 3.8 million tons, although still up from last year and would be the second-largest on record. Total supplies, however, are projected down from a year ago based on reduced carryin. (For reference, 2018/19 beginning stocks were unusually high following the record 2017/18 crop.) In light of this month's production cut, Russia exports are lowered by 2.5 million tons to 34.5 million. This represents a year-to-year reduction of 1.5 million tons, which is attributable to tighter overall supplies.

Even with its exports down slightly, Russia is still forecast to be the world's leading exporter for the third straight year. The next largest supplier, the European Union, is expected to benefit from reduced Russian competition and will likely garner greater market share in North Africa, Sub-Saharan Africa, and the Middle East. The European Union is projected to export 27.0 million tons, up slightly from last month and up 3.0 million from the previous year. Despite a production cut this month, EU wheat supplies are still projected up significantly from last year, which will support both greater exports and additional feed use. The United States is also expected to benefit from reduced Russian competition as U.S. wheat exports (July-June trade year) are raised by 2.0 million tons this month to 25.5 million.

WHEAT

OVERVIEW FOR 2019/20


Global production is lowered this month as smaller crops in Australia, Canada, the European Union, Russia, and Ukraine more than offset a larger U.S. crop. Global trade is lowered, mainly on reduced imports for Indonesia and Vietnam. Exports are projected lower for Australia, Russia, and Ukraine, creating further opportunities for the European Union and the United States. The U.S. season-average farm price is up \$0.10 per bushel to \$5.20.

OVERVIEW FOR 2018/19

For 2018/19, global production and trade are down slightly. U.S. exports are reduced and the season-average farm price is lowered \$0.04 per bushel to \$5.16.

WHEAT PRICES

<u>Domestic</u>: Prices for most classes of U.S. wheat fell slightly during the month of June, weighed by the continuing advance of the U.S. harvest. Hard Red Winter (HRW) and Soft White Winter (SWW) fell \$4/ton to \$227 and \$233, respectively, while Hard Red Spring (HRS) fell \$8/ton to \$239. Conversely, Soft Red Winter (SRW) rose \$8/ton to \$231 with concerns remaining about the impact of wet weather on both the size and the quality of the crop. SRW is now holding a rare premium to HRW.



U.S. Daily FOB Export Bids

<u>Global</u>: Overall, exporter prices were mixed during the month of June. Black Sea milling prices had the largest price decline and U.S. prices also dipped – both with the onset of winter wheat harvesting. Similar to last year, Black Sea wheat is starting off the marketing year very competitively priced, which will likely contribute to another fast start to its export season. EU wheat prices are up marginally as concerns over hot and dry conditions have more than offset the impact of harvest pressure. Argentina and Australia are up with seasonally tight supplies.



RICE

OVERVIEW FOR 2019/20

Global rice production is revised slightly higher this month but still lower than last year's record, with a larger crop in the United States offsetting a smaller crop in Brazil. Lower exports for Thailand are reflected in lower imports for China and Nigeria. Stocks are revised slightly higher and at a record.


OVERVIEW FOR 2018/19

Global rice production is forecast at a record, despite reductions in estimates for Thailand and Madagascar this month. Global trade is forecast lower with reduced purchases for China and lower exports for Thailand.

RICE PRICES

Global: Over the past month, export quotes from the Western Hemisphere have remained elevated, with Uruguay reflective of the tightening regional supply situation at \$528/ton. U.S. quotes rose slightly then returned to \$505/ton. Likewise, Thai prices rose and then fell back to \$404/ton amid currency fluctuations. Thai quotes have remained elevated above other Asian origins for the past several months, hampering Thai export competitiveness. Indian and Pakistani quotes remained around \$375/ton. Meanwhile, Vietnamese quotes rose slightly to \$340/ton on continued buying interest from the Philippines.




Increasing Brazil Imports Provide Relief for Mercosur Neighbors

Mercosur, officially called the Southern Common Market, is a South American trade bloc comprised of Argentina, Brazil, Paraguay, and Uruguay. Combined, these four countries dominate rice production and exports in Latin America. In 2018/19, Mercosur is estimated to produce 9.5 million tons of rice, of which 2.4 million tons are expected to be exported.

The export trends in this region are very much dependent upon Brazil, the largest rice producer and consumer. It is also the only country in the region that is a major importer, historically almost entirely supplied by Mercosur neighbors. Following a long-term trend of a reduction in planted area due to the expansion of soy, Brazil's recently harvested 2018/19 rice crop was smaller than the previous year. With lower domestic supplies. Brazil's exports are forecast to fall from over 1.2 million tons in trade year 2017/18 to only 650,000 tons in 2019/20. In fact, in 2019/20 it is expected to once again be a net importer.

Brazil's growing imports bode well for export-dependent Argentina, Paraguay, and Uruguay, which have been losing market share outside South America. This has been particularly evident in Africa and the Middle East, where they face strong competition from less expensive Chinese rice. Likewise, the United States is





regaining market share from some of Mercosur's trading partners in Central America. As a result, Brazil is forecast to account for nearly half of other Mercosur member's exports, a proportion similar to other years with smaller Brazilian crops such as 2009/10 and 2015/16. This trend is likely to continue into 2019/20 with Brazil's high-cost production declining even further. Additionally, lower-priced rice from Paraguay, Uruguay, and Argentina enters Brazil duty-free under Mercosur.

COARSE GRAINS

OVERVIEW FOR 2019/20

Global corn production is forecast up with larger crops for Ukraine and the United States. Global trade is up slightly from last month driven by larger imports for Zimbabwe. On the exporter side, higher exports for Ukraine offset a reduction for Brazil. The U.S. season-average farm price is down \$0.10 to \$3.70 per bushel.


OVERVIEW FOR 2018/19

Global corn production is up this month driven primarily by a record crop for Argentina. Global trade is up as larger exports for Argentina and Brazil more than offset a sharp cut for the United States. The U.S. season-average farm price is unchanged at \$3.60 per bushel.

CORN PRICES


Global: Since the June WASDE, U.S. bids have fluctuated but ended up \$9/ton to \$200 as U.S. production uncertainty keeps prices elevated. The NASS *Acreage* report estimated U.S. planted area above market expectations. However, with more than 15 percent of the crop remaining to be planted at the time of the survey, uncertainty persists over what has actually been planted. NASS will resurvey essentially all the major corn producing states during July, and should those results merit any changes, they will be published in the August *Crop Production* report. South American bids have closely followed U.S. price movements. Argentine bids were up \$11/ton to \$185 and Brazilian bids were up \$12/ton to \$186. Black Sea bids rose \$16/ton to \$195.

MARKET FEATURE

U.S. Oats Imports Nearly a Mirror Image of Canadian Exports

Global oats trade is expected to expand by 20 percent in 2019/20, driven almost entirely by an increase in Canadian exports to the United States. Despite the European Union and Russia both growing more oats, only a small percentage of this production is currently exported. Canada-U.S. trade makes up about two-thirds of the world's oats trade. Though EU oats once made up an appreciable amount of U.S. imports, Canada now supplies, on average, 95 percent of total oats imports for the United States. As a result of uncertainty in rapeseed trade with China, some growers have shifted away from rapeseed to grow more barley and oats. The close oats trade relationship between Canada and the United States means the jump in Canadian oats production and corresponding expansion in exports will logically flow south.

In the United States, feed demand is the most responsive to an increased availability of oats. Oats are commonly used as feed for racehorses but can also be fed to calves. Some of this increased oat feeding could be a regional response to locally tightening corn supplies. In contrast, food, seed, and industrial use has remained relatively flat over the past decade, despite nutritional labeling of oats as a "heart-healthy" food from its beta-glucan content. For industrial uses, oats are incorporated into skin care and cosmetic products for the emollient properties. Though traditional preparations of oats for products such as oatmeal and granola almost certainly dominate food uses, the growing popularity of the non-dairy alternative "oat milk" may be an interesting, albeit very small, component of demand.

<u>Local Marketing Years (LMY)</u>: LMY refers to the 12-month period at the onset of the main harvest, when the crop is marketed (i.e., consumed, traded, or stored). The year first listed begins a country's LMY for that commodity (2016/17 starts in 2016); except for summer grains in certain Southern Hemisphere countries and for rice in selected countries, where the second year begins the LMY (2016/17 starts in 2017). <u>Stocks:</u> Unless otherwise stated, stock data are based on an aggregate of differing local marketing years and should not be construed as representing world stock levels at a fixed point in time.

<u>Consumption:</u> World totals for consumption reflect total utilization, including food, seed, industrial, feed, and waste; as well as differences in local marketing year imports and local marketing year exports. Consumption statistics for regions and individual countries, however, reflect food, seed, industrial, feed, and waste only.

<u>Trade:</u> All PSD tables are balanced on the different local marketing years. All trade tables contain Trade Year (TY) data which puts all countries on a uniform, 12-month period for analytical comparisons: wheat is July/June; coarse grains, corn, barley, sorghum, oats, and rye are Oct/Sept; and rice is calendar year.

<u>EU Consolidation:</u> The trade figures starting from 1999/00 represent the European Union (Croatia plus the former EU-27) and exclude all intra-trade. For the years 1960/61 through 1998/99, figures are the EU-15 and also exclude all intra-trade. EU-15 member states' data for grains are no longer maintained in the official USDA database. Data for the individual NMS-10, plus Bulgaria, Romania, and Croatia, exists only prior to 1999/00.

<u>Statistics</u>: (1) Wheat trade statistics include wheat, flour, and selected pasta products on a grain equivalent basis. (2) Rice trade statistics include rough, brown, milled, and broken on a milled equivalent basis. (3) Coarse grains statistics include corn, barley, sorghum, oats, rye, millet, and mixed grains but exclude trade in barley malt, millet, and mixed grains.

<u>Unaccounted:</u> This term includes grain in transit, reporting discrepancies in some countries, and trade to countries outside the USDA database.
