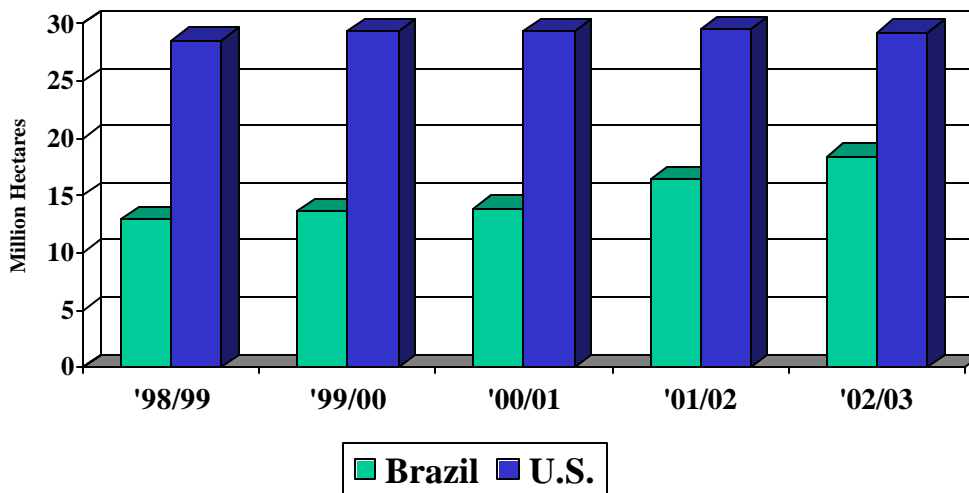




# Oilseeds: World Markets and Trade

## Brazil's Record Harvest in 2002/03 Narrows Gap with U.S. Soybeans



A dramatic increase in Brazil's soybean acreage over the past 5 years has reduced the gap between U.S. and Brazilian soybean production. Since 1998/99, Brazil's harvested acreage has grown from 12.9 million hectares to 18.4 million hectares; an increase of 43 percent over five years. This in turn has increased Brazil's soybean area relative to the U.S. from just under half in 1998/99 to nearly two-thirds of U.S. harvested acreage in 2002/03. As a result, South American production has taken on a greater role in setting world soybean prices by reducing the impact U.S. production has in determining world soybean availability. Increased soybean production in Brazil has also contributed to a decline in the U.S. share of world exports, dropping from 57 percent to 43 percent since 1998/99. Attractive returns relative to competing crops is helping to spur expansion in soybean plantings in Brazil. Additional investment in infrastructure along with technology advances should help keep production costs low in future years leading to continued expansion.

## **Situation and Outlook**

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The world oilseed export forecast for 2002/03 rose 388,000 tons this month to 75.4 million tons. The increase was led by gains in soybeans and sunflowerseed, up 327,000 and 104,000 tons, respectively. Most of the increase in soybean exports accrued to Brazil, which was up 300,000 tons as a result of increased imports by China. Exports of copra also increased, up 32,000 tons, while exports of rapeseed decreased 45,000 tons, and peanuts decreased 27,000 tons.

World ending stocks of all oilseeds estimated by USDA increased this month by more than 1 million tons to 35 million. However, this is still down from the high in 01/02 of 36.5 million. The overall increase in ending stocks is mainly attributable to increased soybean stocks in Brazil, up 555,000 tons, the United States, up 136,000 tons and China, up 210,000 tons. Rapeseed ending stocks are forecast 120,000 tons higher.

The world oilseed crush forecast increased to 269.5 million tons, up 125,000 tons from last month's estimate. Leading the increase in oilseed crush is China where soybean crush for 2002/03 was increased 400,000 tons this month to 24.4 million tons and Brazil where soybean crush was increased 100,000 tons. These increases were nearly offset by decreases in soybean crush of 335,000 tons in India and 136,000 tons in the United States. Estimates of peanut crush are down 154,000 tons this month and sunflowerseed crush are down 138,000 tons.

The total oilseed meal export forecast for 2002/03 decreased 420,000 tons this month to 63.0 million tons. Soybean meal exports were decreased 485,000 tons, offset by a 100,000 ton increase in rapeseed meal exports. There were only minor changes in the remaining oilseed meal export estimates.

The vegetable oil production forecast for 2002/03 increased 353,000 tons this month to 93.3 million tons, primarily due to an increased production forecast for palm oil of 400,000 tons. Imports of vegetable oils rose 688,000 tons to 39.3 million, led primarily by palm oil and soybean oil, up 325,000 tons and 298,000 tons respectively.
